Subject: Revocation of MCI Circulars [234/2020](#) and [255/2021](#)

Date: 19th October 2022

Summary:

Maritime Cook Islands would like to inform all the interested parties that Circular [234/2020](#) and [Circular 255/2021](#) have been revoked effective immediately.

For what concerns [Circular 234/2020](#), MCI would like to highlight that the sample SEA attached to the Circular is to be considered superseded and is not to be used any longer. Owners and Managers are urged to make sure that the SEAs used onboard their vessels are in compliance with the MLC Standard A2.1, including paragraph 7.

For what concerns [Circular 255/2021](#), in light of the amendments to the MLC Appendices A2-I and A4-I, which have been approved on 13 May 2022, MCI will accept P&I Insurance policies (including evidence of financial security under Regulation 2.5 and evidence of financial security under Regulation 4.2) issued in the name of the shipowner or of the registered owner.
